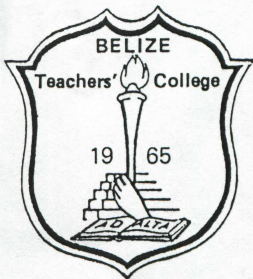
Dear Dr. Young,

Since the meeting of the Consortium for Belizean Educational Cooperation (COBEC) on June 9 and 10, I have received from Mr. Dorian Barrow, the minutes of Friday's meeting and from Dr. Betty Flinchum (and Dr. Pritchey Smith) minutes for Saturday's meeting. Since then, I have also received a synopsis of Saturday's meeting from Mr. Joey Belisle. I have posted copies of Mr. Barrow's minutes as well as a copy of the Memorandum of Agreement, to all members of the Consortium for whom we have addresses. In an effort to provide each member with a complete set of minutes and other related papers from the meetings, I am circulating both Friday's and Saturday's minutes (Dorian Barrow's and Pritchey Smith's along with copies of the Memorandum of Agreement. Points to be addressed

- b) The development of an Educational Research Institute.
(S. Woods and C. Thompson)
- c) Dr. Harold Bergsma to set up system for payment of dues by members. A I believe this is urgent
- d) Ms. Sylvia Cattouse to contact USAID to get information about the Denton Amendment assistance to ship goods to Belize.
- e) Dr. Otis King to send to Dr. Cal copies of materials from SACS and TSU to use in designing programs at UCB.
